

# **November 13, 1833 at Niagara [print] (Artifact 110)**

## **Artifact**

Black and white print designed and published by F. E. Belden of Battle Creek, Michigan in 1901 portraying the Leonid meteor shower of November 13, 1833 as seen over the Niagara Falls. The design area measures 12 in. x 21 in. and is signed "Belden & Goodrich."

F. E. Belden is believed to be the hymn writer, Franklin Edson Belden. While primarily known as a songwriter and superintendent at the Review and Herald Publishing House, it is known that he had an interest in other forms of art.
