

# **Rowland Chest of Drawers (Artifact 129)**

## **Artifact**

Chest of drawers measuring 37" high, 26.5" wide, and 20" deep, constructed of wood with wooden drawer pulls. Neil Rowland made this chest of drawers as part of a set for his sister Lola Rowland Pogue. Everett Dick's notes indicate this was about 1938. In 2014, Lola claimed her brother made this furniture about 1940 for her and her newly wed husband.

Neil Rowland loaned this furniture to Harvey C. Hartman for his proposal to the Union College Board to establish a furniture factory on campus. The furniture factory opened in 1940 in the newly constructed Don Love Building.

Uncertain. Likely a gift of the Rowland-Pogue family.
