

Union College Administration Building Plate 1891-1975 (Artifact 152)

Artifact

The decorative souvenir plate measures 10.25" in diameter and depicts the original Union College administration building which was built in 1890-1891 and demolished in 1975. The plate is cream-colored with gold edge. It was manufactured in Appomattox, Virginia by the Preston-Hopkinson Company.
