Steamer Trunk, circa 1914-1917, belonged to Hugh Hamilton of Great Britain who attended Union College 1931-1932.

Provenance

Hugh Hamilton willed the steamer trunk to the Stone Tower Seventh-day Adventist Church in Oregon when he died January 29, 1989. The trunk was later donated to Luralwood Academy where Oscar Gerst noticed the shipping label on it addressed to Union College. Gerst brought the trunk to Union College on September 18, 1989.
