# **Pearl L. Hall Collection**

## (Collection 8)

### **Scope and Content**

Pearl L. Hall (1904-1988) taught French and Spanish at Union College from 1938 until about 1970. During summer breaks she traveled extensively around the world and this collection includes photographs and postcards acquired on these trips. The collection also includes Hall's notes, manuscripts for two secondary Spanish textbooks, and a manuscript for book-length story, *Call Me Pearly-Gates*.
