# **Joshua C. Turner Family Collection**

## (Collection 9)

### **Scope and Content**

Joshua Caleb Turner (1890-1991) was born near Goldsberry, Missouri. He and his first wife, Winnie Walters both attended Union College (1922-1926) and were lifelong employees of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination. After years at Campion Academy, the South American Division, and Ozark Academy where Turner was principal, they began service in Adventist higher education. Turner served Southwestern Adventist College as a teacher and department head and Union College as grounds director from 1948-1969. After retirement, Union College appointed him assistant professor emeritus. The Turners had one daughter named Margery. Winnie died in 1983 and Turner subsequently married Jewell Church.

This collection contains letters and a special edition of the *Golden Cords* belonging to the Turners.

### **Arrangement**

The arrangement of the collection has been done by the Union College Library Heritage Room.

### **Provenance**

The Loughborough letter and 1926 Golden Cords were given to Union College by the Turners' daughter, Margery Wheaton.
