Rubber stamp of Asa Smith's autograph. The stamp is 2.5" x 2.75" and has a brown wood handle.

Throughout his long career, Asa Smith (1868-1960) worked both in and out of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination. At various times he was a teacher, colporteur, editor, and Wyoming Conference secretary-treasurer.
