

# **South Hall Donation Plaque (Artifact 161)**

## **Artifact**

Metal plaque measuring 16 ½" x 8"

## **Provenance**

Plant Services provided it to us while cleaning up part of their shop. It came attached with a small note saying "IN summer of 1959 an addition to South Hall (now Culver Residence Hall) was Begun to accommodate the influx of men at Union College. This wing, on the North of the building, formed a U and had originally been projected to be built when then building was new. The wing was completed in the fall of 1960 and a \$75,000 gift from the Ida L. Kinney estate aided in the cost of the addition. Total cost of the entire building was \$785,080.64. Dr and Mrs. W.D. Kinney attended Union College in the late 1800s". It also describes what is inscribed on the plaque.
